Read Luke 24:18-26.

Read John 5:39. Who do the Scriptures testify about?				

## **Seeking the Crucified God**

Revealing the Father through the Son

Read John 14:5-9.

Thomas doubted they knew the way. Philip wanted to see the Father. Who does Jesus point them to in both occasions?

The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit

Read John 14:16-18, 14:25-26; 15:26

In Matthew 11:25-26, Jesus said, "I praise You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants. Yes, Father, for this way was well-pleasing in Your sight." If infants can receive God's revelation, why do you suppose we need the Spirit to learn what God wants to teach us? Shouldn't it be easy?

Read 1 Corinthians 1:18-25. How is the cross and the message of the cross described multiple times in these verses? \_\_\_\_\_\_ In verse 25, it says, "the weakness of God." Does God have a weakness? Did He become weak?

General Revelation

Centers on God's power and perfection in creation, in which our conscience accuses us we have failed to reach that standard.

Special Revelation

Centers on God's weakness in the cross for our sake, which is powerful to save.
